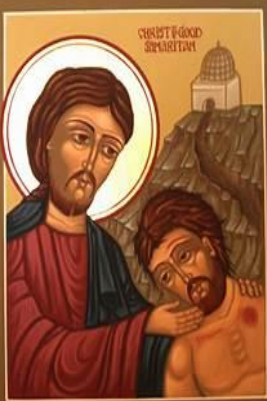


25th Sunday after Pentecost
